Support the Uluru Statement from the Heart

During the NAIDOC Week 2022 at the meeting on Wednesday 6th July, CCCAV Committee resolved to fully support *the Uluru Statement from the Heart*, which calls for the establishment of a First Nations Voice in the Constitution and a Makarrata Commission to “supervise a process of agreement-making between governments and First Nations and truth-telling about our history.”

We support the call for the establishment of a First Nations Voice enshrined in the Australian Constitution and for a referendum to amend the Constitution accordingly, and a Makarrata Commission for agreement-making and truth-telling between Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples and governments.

CCCAV now calls on all Chinese-Australian organisations and fellow Chinese Australians to support *the Uluru Statement from the Heart*, to join the national dialogue to make a First Nations Voice be heard in the Australian Parliament and be protected in the Australian Constitution. We can make a difference by supporting *the Uluru Statement from the Heart* and working together with all Australians for a better future.
