

SEEKING CHINESE-AUSTRALIAN PARTICIPANTS FOR A MONASH UNIVERSITY RESEARCH PROJECT EXPLORING INTER-CULTURAL RELATIONSHIPS IN AUSTRALIA

This research aims to explore how differences in life experiences and identity shape attitudes towards and experiences of intimate intercultural relationships among a range of cultural groups in Australia.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

Participate in **1 hour interview**. The interview will cover: life experiences, identity, the attitudes of family, friends, and community towards intercultural relationships.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

People who:

- Identify as coming from a Chinese background who are in a relationship with Anglo/European Australians, OR
- Anglo/European Australians who are in a relationship with a person who is Australian born and of second generation or higher Chinese background
- Are between the ages of 25-34
- Were born in Australia (second or higher generation)
- Are single or in any relationship status (such as dating, in a de-facto partnership, or married) with a person from a different cultural background
